**REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF OCTOBER**

**04/10/24 ONLINE SESSION:-**

On 4th October, our DFT management organized an online session for the KG coordinators. The session primarily focused on learning outcomes, the importance of early childhood education, handwriting improvement, curriculum structure, and fostering effective interaction between children and teachers. The Academic Coordinator, Mr. Vijimon Iyyapan, emphasized incorporating LSRW (Listening, Speaking, Reading, Writing) skills for KG students and encouraged teachers to aim for high-quality learning outcomes. He also requested coordinators to begin planning activities for the 2025–26 academic year, with a curriculum distribution of 60% assessment-based and 40% activity-based learning. He also insisted us to follow the SWOT analysis for each individual child.

**07/10/24 SAFETY DAY:-**

On 7th October, our Principal conducted a safety check of the school for Safety Day. She inspected all vehicles, fire safety equipment, classrooms, labs, the garden, and restrooms. This was done to ensure a safe and secure environment for everyone in the school.





### **07/10/24 STAFF MEETING:-**

On 7th October, we had a staff meeting with our Rev. Fr. Administrator and principal to discuss topics such as fee collection, Annual Day, a one-day picnic and tour for higher classes, parents' meeting, online coordinators' meeting, and teacher sessions by grade level. Fr. Administrator instructed teachers to remind parents to pay the fees during the upcoming parents' meeting. He also mentioned the one-day picnic and asked the teachers to discuss possible locations for the picnic and tour. The Principal informed staff that online meetings would be conducted for the coordinators according to each grade level.

### **08/10/24 REVIEW MEETING WITH 10<sup>TH</sup> AND 12<sup>TH</sup> STAFF:-**

Our Principal conducted quarterly examination review meeting with the teachers handling 10th and 12th grade subjects. The meeting focused on evaluating student performance, discussing areas for improvement, and planning strategies to enhance learning outcomes for the upcoming term.



### **TOPPERS AND BLOOMERS MEETING :-**

On 9th, 16th and 24th our principal conducted a Toppers' and Bloomers meeting for Grade 10 and 12 students. The session aimed at recognizing the high achievers and offering additional support to those needing improvement. Teachers provided personalized feedback and guidance to help all students perform better in the upcoming exams.



**10/10/24 STAFF MEETING FOR THE PRIMARY AND HIGH SCHOOL STAFF:-**  
Coordinators summarized the key discussions from the DFT Academic Coordinator's meeting conducted for primary and high school coordinators. They highlighted important action plans, academic strategies, and any updates related to curriculum and student progress, ensuring all team members were informed and aligned.





### **10/10/24:AYUDHA POOJA BLESSINGS:-**

On the 10th of October, our school celebrated Ayudha Pooja. Rev. Fr. Lourdasamy MMI, the Administrator, and Rev. Fr. Lucas MMI led the prayer and blessed all the vehicles, classrooms, office, registers, and keys.



### **12/10/24 VIJAYDHASAMI ADMISSION :-**

On 12th October, we held Vijayadashami admissions for the kindergarten children. The KG teachers welcomed the children with chocolates and sweets. They conducted the Vidyarambam ceremony, guiding each child to write the Tamil letter ' ' in the paddy. Rev. Fr. Administrator and our Principal blessed and wished the new children.



#### 14/10/24 PARENTS TEACHERS MEETING :

On 14th October, in the presence of our principal a parent-teacher meeting was held for Grade 10 and 12 students to discuss their performance in the Quarterly Exams. The meeting aimed to update parents on their child's progress, address any concerns, and provide guidance for improvement. Teachers shared detailed feedback on each student's strengths and areas needing attention, emphasizing the importance of consistent preparation for the upcoming board exams. Parents were encouraged to support their children's academic efforts at home. The meeting concluded with an interactive session, allowing parents to ask questions and discuss strategies to help students excel in their studies.





### **15/10/2024 AUDIO ASSESSMENT:-**

On 15th of October our students from Grade 6 to Grade 8 had their Audio assessment programme to enhance the students to increase their listening level. The primary goal of this assessment was to evaluate the students' ability to understand, interpret, and respond to spoken information. This evaluation measured their comprehension skills, attention to detail, and ability to process auditory information effectively.



### **17/10/24 - COMPETITION:**

On account of Dr. Abdul Kalam's birth anniversary, our school conducted a drawing and coloring competition for students from KG to Grade 8. Students were given different topics according to their grade level, and teachers instructed them to draw and color pictures based on their assigned topics. The students participated enthusiastically in the competition.



**18/10/24 – FIELD TRIP AND GUIDANCE PROGRAMME:**

Our students from Grades 6 to 12 attended a science session at Christ The King Engineering College. During the visit, they toured the lab facilities, observed various machines, and received explanations from the college staff about each machine's functions and applications. This hands-on experience helped students gain practical insights into engineering concepts and enhanced their understanding of scientific principles in real-world contexts.



### **19/10/24 OPEN DAY:**

On 19th October, our school held an Open Day for parents of students from KG to Grade 9, as well as Grade 11, to review their children's marks for the 1st Terminal Examination. This event provided an opportunity for parents to meet with teachers, discuss their child's academic progress, and address any concerns. The session aimed to strengthen communication between parents and teachers, fostering a collaborative approach to support each student's learning and growth.



### **19/10/24 STAFF MEETING:-**

On 19th October, we held a staff meeting with our Rev. Fr. Administrator and Principal to discuss feedback from parents received on Open Day. Rev. Fr. Administrator assigned in-charge teachers for the 2nd term and reviewed the status of fee collection for each class. He emphasized the importance of maintaining classroom cleanliness and instructed teachers to remind students accordingly. Additionally, plans for the upcoming Annual Day program were discussed.

### **24/10/24 LISTENING ASSESSMENT PROGRAM FOR GRADES 1 TO 8:-**

On 24th October, a listening assessment program was conducted for students from Grades 1 to 8, designed to enhance listening skills and encourage better auditory comprehension. Listening is a fundamental skill, and this assessment aimed to provide students with the opportunity to practice and improve their listening abilities, which are critical for academic success and effective communication. During the assessment, students were presented with various audio recordings, ranging from simple instructions to short stories and informational content, adjusted according to grade levels. Each recording required them to listen attentively and then answer questions or complete tasks based on what they heard.

On 24th October, our students participated in a kumite session as part of their extracurricular activities. Kumite, a form of sparring in martial arts, helped students practice discipline, focus, and self-control while learning essential self-defense techniques. This activity not only enhanced their physical abilities but also fostered confidence and teamwork.



#### **24/10/24: KARATE COMPETITION:-**


## 28/10/2024 DIWALI AWARENESS PROGRAMME
