- Teachers explained the features of each season.

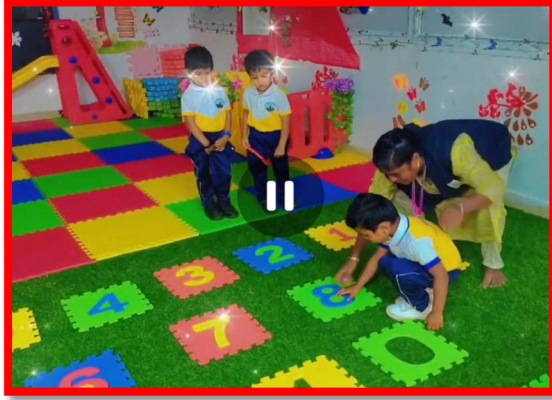
- Students dressed according to the seasons.
