Standard I

Maths: Comparison of objects

Standard V

Students have done their classroom activities for the below subjects

Science: The classroom activity aimed to provide students with hands-on under stings of the digestive and respiratory systems, enhancing their comprehension through interactive learning. Students were divided into small groups, with each group assigned a specific part of either the digestive or respiratory system. This division allowed the children to explore each component.



Social : This classroom activity aimed to enhance students' understanding of the solar system, including the planets, moons and other celestial bodies through interactive and engaging learning methods. Each students conducted research using textbooks, class notes and drawn the chart paper to explain the Solar System.



Maths: The activity was conducted mainly for the students to identify the various 3D shapes, their properties, and their real-life applications. The Teacher provided 3D models of various shapes. Students had the opportunity to handle the models, identify their properties and understand their spatial relationship. They also made dummy models of 3D shapes.

Standard VI



Maths: This activity was conducted to help the students to know the concept of face value and place value in numbers through the creation and use of face value charts. The students were tasked with creating face value charts of their assigned numbers. They accomplished the task by using paper and markers to write down the numbers.

Social: The result of the activity is to provide students with hands-on understanding of historical artifacts through the exploration of old coin collection and Olai Chuvadi highlighting their cultural and historical significance.

Science: This activity is handled by the teacher to teach the students the concept of balance and equilibrium through hands-on experiments and interactive learning.

Science: The aim of the activity is to make the students about the basics of measurement, including the use of different measurement tools.

Standard VIII

Science: The activity is mainly focussed on the students to know about different types of clocks, their mechanism, and how to read time, through interactive and hands-on learning.
