02/09/2024 WORLD COCONUT DAY AND MONTESSORI DAY ASSEMBLY BY KG and Grade 3:-

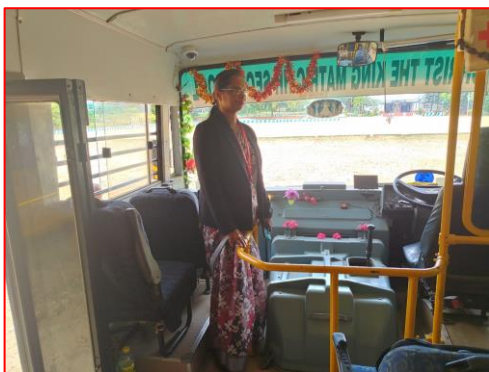
09/09/2024 NATIONAL TEDDY BEAR DAY ACTIVITY BY LKG:-

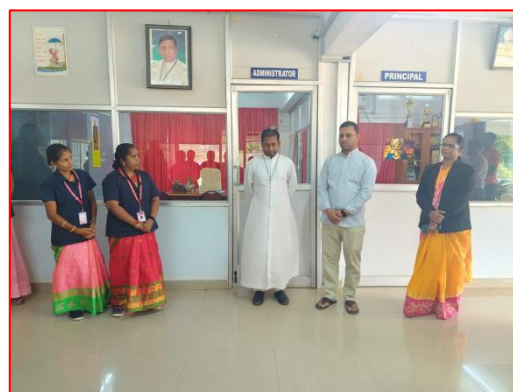


19/09/2024 THE START OF FIRST TERMINAL EXAMINATION:-

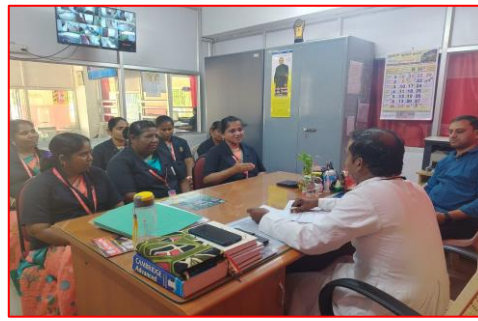
20/09/2024 CORRESPONDENT'S MEETING WITH TEACHERS:-
